Dear Parent / Guardian,

As the weather forecast is now promising better weather (hopefully!) pupils will be able to wear tailored black, knee-length school shorts (traditional material rather than sports' shorts) from now onwards until the end of this Summer term: 20 July, 2018, if they so wish. Only woven fabrics will be permitted, not knitted fabrics (i.e. no fabrics that stretch). Lycra and denim shorts will not be permitted).

If pupils don't wish to wear shorts then that's absolutely fine, of course, but I would like to remind the pupils that they are not permitted to wear jeans to school.

In terms of shoes, ideally, sturdy leather shoes are preferable, but we will accept canvas shoes or trainers as long as they are black, plain with no logos or colourful stripes, boots or high-top styles are not acceptable. Shoes must also be sturdy enough to afford students adequate protection from the weather conditions and be suitable and safe for the Technology Block workshops and laboratory lessons in school. Pupils should wear short black socks without a pattern.

I would like to take this opportunity to remind the pupils that they are not permitted to wear 'hoodies' in School and that the official School fleece is for sale in the Main Reception.
