

SUPERHEROES

Spring Term 2017 - Years 1 and 2



During this term pupils from Years 1 and 2 will be following a new theme from the 'Cornerstones' scheme of work. The theme will be 'Superheroes'. This project focuses on developing IT (computing) skills, and during the term the pupils will receive numerous opportunities to draw, paint, design and create masks, animate, role play and record sounds. Their writing skills will be enhanced through writing descriptions, narratives, dialogues and fantasy stories. They will also begin to learn about speech marks and bubble writing. This exciting theme is sure to fire your child's imagination, and they will have an opportunity to create their own superhero and to develop that character. It is also important to remember that every child will develop and mature in their own time.



Language, Literacy and Communication

- describe/create a profile of a superhero
 - role play
- ask and answer questions - invited guests e.g. fireman
- use ITC to record and create pictures
- reading skills - books, magazines, comics, story boards, cartoon strips
 - create a story strip
- develop and enhance vocabulary
 - use a dictionary
- Write factual and fictional work



Mathematics

- develop number skills - daily use of the 100 square
- add, subtract, divide and multiply according to their ability
 - measure and money
- timelines - order of day/the clock
- days of the week/months of the year/seasons



Personal and Social Education

- * good and bad character - be able to differentiate
- * create a 'moral' character to help deal with bullying/road safety/rubbish disposal/friendships
- * learn about healthy snacks
- * the importance of drinking enough water
- * mischievous superheroes/good superheroes - learn about the effects of good/bad behaviour



Physical

- adventurous play
- moving safely
- travelling - stepping, jumping, landing, transferring weight, balancing, rolling, turning and spinning, climbing, swinging - movements on the floor and use of apparatus
 - throwing and catching a ball

Religious Education

- helping others e.g. Jesus healing the sick
 - work as a team e.g. Noah's Ark
