- ▶ Gwnewch yn siŵr bod eich plentyn yn mynd i'r sesiwn adolygu ac arholiad gyda'r adnoddau cywir (pen, pensil, ffon fesur, cyfrifiannell, onglydd).
- ▶ Gwnewch yn siŵr eich bod yn gwybod amserlen arholiadau eich plentyn - dylai'r disgyblion fod yn yr ysgol erbyn 8.45 ar gyfer arholiad bore ac erbyn 12.45 ar gyfer arholiad prynhawn.

Dear Parent / Guardian,


This year will be the most important period of your child's education so far and in order for each pupil to be as successful as possible it is important that the link between school and home is strong. GCSE attainment is positively influenced by the level of parental engagement. The more parents get involved, the higher the level of attainment.

Parents have the greatest influence on the achievement of pupils through supporting their learning in the home. It is your support of learning within the home environment that makes the maximum difference to achievement. Thank you, in advance, for your support.

Here are some suggestions on how you can fully support your child and their teachers' efforts during this period:


- ▶ Attendance needs to be 100%. Currently, the average attendance of our Year 11 students is 91.9%.
- ▶ Ensure that your child completes homework by the deadlines set so that they can receive constructive and timely feedback.
- ▶ Provide a dedicated, supervised quiet space for homework.
- ▶ Monitor the use of social media and the internet in general – try to reduce distractions during revision sessions at home.
- ▶ Encourage your child to use revision websites and materials.
- ▶ Be sympathetic about the regular tests but try to ensure that the pupils revise!
- ▶ Encourage your child to go to revision sessions – these are offered at lunchtimes as well as after school and during school holidays in the run-up to the exams. There will be a timetable of these sessions available on the school website.
- ▶ Encourage your child to speak to their teacher if they are finding the work difficult.
- ▶ Give your child lots of praise and encouragement.
- ▶ Ensure that your child comes fully equipped for revision sessions and exams (pens, pencil, ruler, calculator, compass and protractor).
- ▶ Ensure that you are fully aware of your child's exam timetable – pupils should be in school by 8.45am for morning exams and by 1.00pm for afternoon exams.
- ▶ Contact Mrs Nerys Stephens, Head of Phase, if you have any concerns
- ▶ Visit the school website for more strategies and revision tips.
