- The pupils will be able to arrange an appointment at the School if they require further advice: the appointments can take place from 10am onwards on 10 August. In order to arrange an appointment, an e-mail will need to be sent to J.Wyn2@bropedr.ceredigion.sch.uk
- The arrangements for the appointment system will include clear instructions regarding the room where the meeting will take place and a one-way system will need to be adhered to in the Main Building. The old Main Reception will be the entry point to the building.
- The social distancing 2 metre rule will need to be adhered to at all times and parents and pupils visiting the school site will be asked to wear a face covering.

12 August – date of the GCSE results:

- Before 10am: a member of the School staff will e-mail your child (**HWB e-mail address**) in order to share the results.
